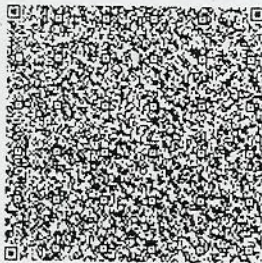

NOW THIS TRUST DEED WITNESSES AS FOLLOWS :-

1. In order effectuate the said object of creating and establishing a Public Charitable Trust, the Founder/Settler has delivered to and make over to the Trust a sum of Rs.11,000/- (Rupees Eleven Thousand only) with an intent to part with all their rights, title and interest claim and vest the same in the Trustees to have and to hold the same and the investment or investments for the time being representing the same and all other properties that may for the time being represent the Trust estate together with all additions and accretions thereto and all accumulated income thereof and all other property or properties that may be acquired out of the same or otherwise may hereafter be subject to the Trust (hereinafter referred to as "THE TRUST FUND") for the charitable objects and purposes and uses hereinafter expressed with the powers and on the terms and conditions herein contained or and concerning the same.
2. The name of the Trust shall be **GOSWAMI EDUCATIONAL TRUST**
3. The Office of the Trust shall be situated at **3/7, SUBHASH NAGAR, NEW DELHI-110027**, which may be changed from time to time to such other place or places as the Trustees may deem fit and proper at their discretion.
4. The Trust could have its unit offices at any place in India and Abroad.
5. The Trust would be shall be deemed to have been established on 24/01/14 Those who are trustees for the purpose and declare that Founder (Mrs. Sanyogita Giri) will continue to be the Executive Trustee/ Managing Trustee of the Trust and one of the Trustees for her life time.
6. **AIMS AND OBJECT OF THE TRUST:-**
 - I. To start, establish, run, take over or manage, educational institutions like schools, colleges, universities, pre-schools, professional and degree colleges and other vocational or technical institutions to promote education and literacy, employability through out the country.

II. To establish, run, maintain, manage and control the various training institution/course/technical/educational, engineering institute, Teacher Training, Religious Temples and specialized studies, research institutes to provide standard and high class education for Diploma, Medical, Dental, Para Medical, Hospital, Diagnostic Centers/Labs, Mass Media Institute, Yoga Institute, Art & Culture Institute, Nursing School, Management Institute, Fashion Institute, Colleges, work on Bank Projects & Projects of UNICEF, Ayurvedic Homoeopathic Naturopathy, Pharmacy, Nursing, Occupational Therapy, Acupuncture and acupressure Therapy centers /dispensaries, Dietician, Beautician training centers, etc. (after getting proper permission from the competent authority i.e. A.I.Q.T.E., N.C.T.E., Ministry of H.R.D., U.G.C State Government etc.

III. To promote, create awareness and conduct regular surveys, assessments, trainings, behaviour and attitudinal training programs in schools, colleges, through out the country.

IV. To create research and content developments teams to constantly create, upgrade, syllabus and modules or articles for publications and education.

V. To introduce and promote life-skills, behavior and attitudinal training centers for the well being of individuals, family and society at large.

VI. To undertake projects, programs and schemes related to education, literacy, awareness and health education, environmental awareness etc. to children adolescents, adults or anyone and everyone who can be benefited by it.

VII. To undertake projects, programs and schemes relating to education and health education such as pre-schools, primary schools, high secondary schools, graduation degree colleges, post graduation colleges, technical institutions, medical institutions, dental institutions, pharmacy college, hospital, charitable dispensaries, medical aid centers/ clinics, home/hostel for women and children maternity homes, nursing homes, child welfare centers, sanatoriums, old age homes and other institutions of similar nature and to run and maintain vocational training institutions for all or any of them.

VIII. To appoint Managing Committee including its Chairman, Manager and Members, for institutions run by the Trust.

IX. To seek and form national and international tie ups, affiliations and collaborations relating to education, life style, well being, of public in constantly upgrading methodology, technology and techniques to have better quality of life for all.

X. To assist and help deserving people both in rural and urban areas in connection with their personal, social and other needs including health, education, marriages etc.

XI. To do all acts, deeds to provide for sanitary facilities and promote preventive and other measures for the health, education, marriage and others.

XII. To establish and run dharamshalas, rest houses, houses for poor or other such charitable institutions for the benefits of all classes at any suitable place or places.

XIII. To help, aid, assist, undertake, organize, establish and maintain for imparting general, vocational, industrial, technical, education besides arts, science and health and promote language education in Indian or foreign languages.

XIV. To assist and provide financial assistance to poor and needy people of the society and for any other causes of general public utility.

XV. To undertake consultancy services projects, programs and schemes relating to promotion, development and improvement of environment of our country and earth. This shall include carbon emissions, global warming, water and land pollution etc. or any other area affecting our environment in general.

XVI. To do all such acts and things as may be conducive to general well being of the society and uplift of social, educational, cultural or economic condition of the masses.

XVII. To fund, assist, support, establish and maintain libraries and reading rooms and establish and maintain boarding houses, hostels or assist such institutions.

- XVIII. To maintain, contribute to give aid to any medical, educational, social institutions or any charitable institutions with philanthropic purposes which may be in the general interest of the poor of all castes and creed and to all such acts and things with the objection of giving relief to the poor.
- XIX. To publish books and magazines for the development of education, uplift of humanity and to distribute them to public with or without charging price.
- XX. To hold and manage the assets and properties acquired/inherited or purchased by the Trust as may be necessary or appropriate for the achievement of the objectives of the Trust.
- XXI. To invest money of the Trust and its funds according to section 11(5) of the IT Act 1961.
- XXII. To open and maintain orphanages, widow homes and homes for the blind and handicapped persons and provide them vocational and other training to render assistance to any such existing institution.
- XXIII. To provide stipends, scholarships and other allowances to deserving and needy students for promotion and encouragement of all type of education.
- XXIV. To conduct training programs for farmers in the field of agriculture and rural development.
- XXV. To establish centers to promote knowledge, general awareness among people in the field of science, art, culture, yoga, industrial development, social and economic development, rural development/management and social changes.
- XXVI. To sponsor programs for release and rehabilitation of child labourers, women labourers and bonded and landless farmers.

XXVII. To publish pamphlets, souvenir, journals, magazines, newspapers, hold exhibitions, workshops, discussions, seminars, theatrical workshops and demonstrations, conferences, exhibitions cum sale, scientific demonstration for the promotion of education, awareness, health education, agriculture, organic agriculture, environment, global warming, carbon emissions, land and water pollution or for any other issue relating to the uplift of people, country and the earth.

XXVIII. To seek and form national and international affiliations, collaborations and tie ups with organizations working for the well being and improvement of the environment in general and to help bring the latest technology and technological development for the benefit and improvement of the environment of our country. This will include global warning, carbon emissions, land and water pollution or any other areas affecting our environment in general.

XXIX. To construct rural link roads, pavements, curve lets and bridges for the employment generation as well as comfort of travel.

XXX. To nurse, plant, make grow the plantation trees of difference species on the waste land in village, town, and metropolitans and in schools, colleges, hospitals, road sides for preventing ecological imbalance/deforestation, to keep check and create pollution free environment.

XXXI. To establish drug de addiction centers/clinics and research centers to facilitate treatment, nursing of drug addicted patients and their rehabilitation and to indemnify the cause/reason which provoke the youth and people into drug addiction and provide suitable treatment.

XXXII. To train and educate women and youth by providing knowledge of cooking, art, learning house decoration, health care and beauty culture, computer (hardware & software) training and development, tourism, fashion designing and gardening.

XXXIII. To promote programs for family planning/Family welfare and population control through demonstration and operation as prescribed by law.

XXXIV. To establish charitable health centers for the welfare of poor and needy people. For this purpose allopathic, ayurvedic, unani homeopathic, naturopathy and other systems of medicines will be adopted.

XXXV. To provide information regarding Leprosy, cancer, aids and other infections and diseases in urban and rural areas, and to render medical facilities and guidance to general public.

XXXVI. To cultivate the spirit of culture among the people by holding music, drama, dance, concerts, debates, lectures and quiz of the entertainment of the people.

XXXVII. To engage for preparation of statutory report for any industry, creating water and air pollution problem and submit exhaustive report of preparation of treatment as and when required under the pollution control act prevailing in different states and govt. of India.

XXXVIII. To undertake construction and maintenance of drinking water supply scheme, hand tube wells and drill tube wells in urban and rural areas.

XXXIX. To undertake construction of low cost houses for the poor in villages and towns. To construct public buildings in urban and rural areas.

XL. To provide legal aid and family counseling services to general public.

XLI. To establish a consumers education and publication center for making the general public aware about the consumer rights.

XLII. To implement saving and credit programs amongst the women through self help groups for urgencies/small income generation programs etc.

XLIII. To assist and co-operate the other Association Trust and the various N.G.O's whose aims are same like this Trust.

XLIV. To purchase/acquire land or approach DDA, MCD, Delhi Administration or any other concerned local and central or state Govt. authorities for allotment of land to open Dharamshala, Old age Home, School, College, institution, training and health center etc.

XLV. To promote Health hygiene measures to prevent STD/HIV/AIDs, awareness about health hazards special campaigning about mass killer disease like T.B., Cholera, Cancer and heart diseases etc. Awareness campaigning about vaccination, pulse polio etc. safe use of drugs to create a Healthy society.

XLVI. To undertake projects, programs and schemes relating to public toilets, bio gas plants, non conventional energy centers including wind cycle, hydro power and solar energy on the basis of recent techniques in the rural, urban areas to help state and central government/local bodies or any other institution/agency for the benefit of the society /general public.

XLVII. To develop sewa dals/human chains throughout nation and the world to train and make conscious people at large to associate themselves in natural calamities and removal of human sufferings.

XLVIII. To accept donation (in cash or kind), subscriptions, grants, presents and to collect dividends, rents, interest and other income for the trust fund to be utilized for furthering the objectives of the Trust thereof.

XLIX. To get income tax exemption under section 80G of Income Tax Act 1961 and other similar and higher registrations from the concerned departments and also FCRA registration and other necessary, similar and higher registrations from the concerned authority/department.

L. The aims and objects of the Trust shall be purely for Charitable, health, educational purposes which includes relief and the advancements of any other objects of General Public Utility.

LI. The Trust will invest its money and funds according to the section 121 (15) of Income Tax Act 1961.

LII. The Trust shall work or arrange employment for the senior citizens.

LIII. To receive financial and non-financial assistance from Govt, Non-Govt. organization, International Agencies Bank and any other legal entity or individual.

INCOME OF THE TRUST:

The Income and property of the Trust shall be utilized solely for the promotion of the objects of the foundation as set out in the charter, no portion of the fund shall be directly or indirectly deserted to any other organization or person. This should identify the trust of Non-profit making organization.

THAT FOR THE FURTHERANCE OF THE OBJECTS OF THE TRUST, THE TRUSTEE SHALL HAVE THE FOLLOWING POWERS:-

All the trustees including Executive Trustee/Founder shall form "BOARD OF TRUSTEES" and all the decisions shall be taken in the meeting of Board of Trustees called from time to time without prejudice to any of the powers that the Trustees may have under any law for the time being, in force or to their general powers for management. The Trustees shall have the following powers:-

- The Founder Mrs. Sanyogita Giri will be the absolute In-charge of the Trust and will exercise all the discretionary and sovereign powers.
- During the life time of founder she can appoint her nominee and after her death the appointed nominee and in case none is appointed then the legal heir will enjoy all the rights of the founder as presently, the founder is enjoying. This process of nomination of successor shall continue till the working of the Trust.
- The General Management and control of the Trust Properties and its affairs shall be vested in the trustees and the trustees shall have power to do all such acts as may be considered necessary for the benefit of the trust and /or management of its properties and affairs, veto power shall always remain with Settler, nominees or the successor/s.
- To enter into contract/agreement with any agencies like the Government authority, Municipal, local and other for the benefit or which may seem conducive to carrying out all the objects and purposes of the foundation or any of them to obtain and carry out exercise and comply with any such contracts agreement or arrangement.

- To invest the money of the trust in such manner and in such investment as the trust may in their absolute dissoning from time to time deem fit so to be in conformity under the provision of any law of provisions of the relevant acts of the government
- To purchase, hire, take on lease land, movable or immovable properties and assets anywhere in India. Accept gifts, grants or loans on such terms and conditions for repayment with interest or otherwise as the trust may consider.
- To open and operate Bank account(s) in the name of Trust/institution, give discretion to transfer, endorse & sign govt. instruments, securities, promissory notes, shares, debentures etc. and all these accounts shall be operated by Trustees jointly and/or severally as decided by them, but the decision of the Founder/Nominee(s) or successor(s) shall be final. To close such accounts with any bank or banks as the Trustees may deem necessary.
- To borrow or receive money with or without security or secured by bonds, mortgages or other securities changed on the undertaking of all or any of the assets of the Trust.
- To institute suits, actions and legal proceedings to prefer appeal, to make applications or petitions and to give affidavits, wherever necessary and to defend or compound, compromise, abandon, submit to arbitration or otherwise settle any suit, action, claim, legal proceedings, appeal, demand or dispute relating to the Trust matters.

- To mortgage the property/assets owned by the Trust or any other individual to raise loans, to meet the aim and objects of the Trust.
- To sign, endorse transfer and negotiate all kind of documents relating to the investment of the funds of the trust in the interest of the trust.
- To receive money and to grant receipts and discharge thereof.
- To transfer any funds and property of the Trust with objects or purposes which are similar to those of the trust and whose income is exempted from any liability by virtue of different sections related to nonprofit making organization.
- To manage the trust fund with life membership donation & legacy to collect and recover interest dividends and income there of and to pay through and out going, if any.
- To pay or utilize the balance of such interest and dividends and income of the trust and if the trust so desired to utilize the corpus of the Trust, if any or part thereof for the trust purpose.
- To institute defend compound compromise or abundant any legal proceedings by or against the trust or its office or otherwise concerning the assets of the Trust and also to compound and allow time of payment or satisfaction of any debt due to be paid and claims or demands by or against the Trust.
- To frame and implement from time to time rules and regulations for the administration of the trust and carrying out of all/any of the trust fund for its aims & purposes.
- To engage the services of any person or persons upon such remuneration and terms as the trust may deem fit proper, to take disciplinary action against them and also to terminate their services.
- To do all such things as may be necessary for the effective functioning of the Trust.
- Every trustee will be at liberty to resign on giving one month's notice of his/her intention to do so.
- To appoint sub-committees comprising One Trustee or more for carrying out the objects and purposes of the Trust or matters connected with the Trust and/or its affairs.

RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE TRUST:

These rules shall called the Rules of the "**GOSWAMI EDUCATIONAL TRUST**" Which shall hereinafter be referred to as the Rules of the Trust.

DEFINITION:

- A. Authorities means the authorities of the Trust.
- B. Government means the Government of Countries.
- C. Chairman means the Managing Trustee of the Trust.
- D. Director means the Director of the Trust.
- E. Board of Management means the Board of Management of the Trust
- F. Year means the Financial Year
- G. Planning Committee means the Planning Committee of the Trust
- H. Finance Committee means the Finance Committee of the Trust
- I. Advisory Committee means the advisory Committee of the Trust

THE FOLLOWING SHALL BE THE AUTHORITIES OF THE TRUST

- A. Board of Trust
 - B. Planning Committee
 - C. Finance Committee
 - D. Advisory Committee
 - E. Any such other authorities as may be deemed necessary by the Board of Management from time to time.
1. The number of the Trustees shall not be less than Four and not more than Seven. The trustees shall be trustees for their life time but any trustee may resign by giving in writing to the Co-trustees. Appointment of Trustee/s shall be only with the final approval of Settler or her nominee/s or the successors.
 2. **TERMS OF MEMBERSHIP** : The Trust shall be managed by Managing Trustee under the guidance of Board of Trust, other than board of Management other Trustee, if any hold office for terms of three years and shall be eligible for re-appointment. Trustee for life shall be entitled to nominate their successors to office of the trust and in the event of a vacancy arising in the office of the trust during the life of the Trustee, the Managing Trustee should nominate successor(s) of the life Trustee in his/her place. The managing Trustee of the Trust shall have subject to the control, discretion and superintendence of the Board of Trustee, all any every power for the purpose of managing conducting and administering the affairs of the Trust and the institution and establishments, owned run or conducted by the Trust, the Board of Trustee shall be complete to transact every and all business by the majority. The Managing Trustee shall have right to cast vote.

ELECTION OF THE NOMINEES:-

The founder Trustee unanimously will be selected nominees for the committee in finance, planning and advisory including female nominee. That Sanyogita Giri is the life time Managing Trustee of the Trust.

MEETING OF THE BOARD

- a. That Board of Trust shall meet at least two times in a year/from time to time as deemed fit by the Trust with not less than 15 days notice, in case of urgency, the meeting may be called by the Chairman/Managing Trustee by giving a notice of not less than days.
- b. Each member of the above body including the Chairman shall have one vote and decision at the meeting of the Board shall be taken by majority. In case of tie, the Chairman shall have a casting vote.
- c. Any business necessary may be carried out by circular and appropriate resolution been passed at the meeting of the Board of the Trust.

POWER AND FUNCTIONS OF MANAGEMENT OF BOARD

The Board of management shall be the Principal executive body of the trust and except as provided otherwise in the Rules/Bye-Laws, shall exercise all powers vested in it and do all such acts and things as may be exercised or done by the Trust.

- a. To manage and regulate the Finance and investments of funds, property and all other administrative affairs of the Trust and for that purpose to appoint such agent or agents as it may deem fit.
- b. To entertain and adjudicate upon and if thought fit to redress any grievances of the employees.
- c. To select an emblem and to have a common seal for the trust and use of such seal.

- d. To institute fellowship scholarship, medals and prizes on the advise of finance committee.
- e. To appoint such committee as the Trust may think deemed fit.
- f. To appoint auditors for the ensuing years.
- g. To open account(s) of the Trust with any one or more scheduled banks and to lay down the procedure for operating the same.
- h. To issue appeals for funds consistent with the object of the Trust or receive grants, donations, contributions, gifts, Prizes, scholarship and other money to give grants and donation to award prizes, scholarship etc.
- i. To draw/accept and make/endorse discount and negotiable promissory notice bills of exchange cheques etc.
- j. To transfer or accept any movable/immovable property on behalf of the Trust.
- k. To provide building or buildings premises, furniture, fittings, equipments, appliances and other facilities required for carrying on the work of the Trust.
- l. To maintain proper accounts and other relevant record and prepare annual statement of account of every previous financial year, in such form as may be prescribed by the Regulations/bye-laws.
- m. To delegate all or any of its powers to any committee constituted by it or agent/agents etc.
- n. To amalgamate the Trust with other institutions, association, Trust, or organization having Public Charitable objects and purposes with the consent of Two-third of trustees in writing.
- o. To nominate, appoint and constitute attorney/s, legal practitioners, agents etc. and to delegate the duties and powers vested in them (Trustees) with regard to the management of the Trust property including starting or defending of legal proceedings or for opening or operating upon accounts with any Bank/s, person/s, firm/s or to do such other acts and duties relating to or connected with the Trust Property as may be deemed necessary.
- p. To appoint/nominate patrons and to give such other designations to various persons extending help for the running or for case of the Trust.
- q. And generally to do all acts, deeds and things as may be necessary for administration of the Trust.

Sewyis

- The trustees will not be entitled to receive the remuneration as Trustees but may reimburse themselves of all expenses actually incurred by them in connection with Trust or their dues thereto.
- The Trustees may from time to time, frame rules for the conduct of the administration of the Trust and regulating the meeting of Trustees, in the absence of such regulations:-
 - i. All the matters will be decided by the majority and the quorum for the meeting shall be two third.
 - ii. A resolution circulated to all Trustees and signed by the majority of such Trustees shall be as valid and effectual as resolution duly passed at a meeting of the trustees.
- The regular accounts will be maintained relating to all receipts, payments, income, expenditure or any property or liabilities relating to the Trust. Further the accounts of the Trust will be audited by a qualified accountant.
- The Board of Trustees shall be entitled to sue in the name of Trust and may similarly be such in the name of Trust.

FUNDS ACCOUNTS AUDIT

- a. The accounts of Trust shall maintained in the name of the Trust. The account of the trust shall be kept in such forms as may be laid down by the Board of the Trust. It shall conform to the rules, if any prescribed by the respective government, wherever the accounts are opened and maintained.

- b. The funds of the Trust will be used only for the purpose/objectives of the Trust.
- c. Annual report and the audit report shall be submitted to the board of Trust within three months of the closure of the accounting year for the needful.

BANKING NORMS:

Any founder, Trustee, Member of the Trust authorized by the Board of Trust or Chairman of the Trust can operate bank account individually/jointly as resolved by the Board of Trust.

INTERPRETATION CLAUSE:

In the event of confusion, contradiction and conflicts of opinion with regard to interpretation of charter Trust or rules and bye-laws the opinion of the founder trustee of the Trust shall prevail.

DISSOLUTION

The dissolution of the Trust may be affected by a Special Resolution Passed by a majority of two third of the trustees present at the Special meeting convened for the purpose and with the consent of the Chairman of the Trust the remains after the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities, any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid or distributed amongst the Trustees of the Trust, but shall be given or transferred to some other like Institutions having same Aims and Objects to be determined by the Board of Trustees at or before the time of dissolution.

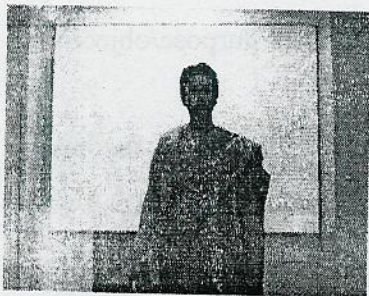
